

E-tool – TOP 10 TIPS

1. Look around you and try to adapt. You will fit in better by observing the way the people act around you.
2. Do not be afraid to speak! You'll learn the language by doing mistakes!
3. Ask questions or talk to your teacher before the departure if you have any doubts and/or fears. It will help you get more confident for your trip.

9. Respect the rules and do not act as if you were in your own country. The rules are different in every country and they are created to supervise and avoid any problems! It ensures that your stay will go smoothly and be unforgettable!
10. Participate in the events of your host country! This way, you will meet local people and make friends!
11. Inform yourself about the forms of politeness in the country of your arrival. It will avoid you some uncomfortable situations!
